From the Chaplain's Desk

*Your wife will be like a fruitful grapevine, flourishing
within your home.*

*Your children will be like vigorous young olive
trees as they sit around your table.*

That is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him.

(Ps 128:3–4, NLT)

What a beautiful picture of a flourishing family, gathering around the father and blessing him. Of course, we read that the blessing comes from the Lord “for those who fear him.”

On June 17th, we will celebrate Father's Day, a day specially set apart to recognize and celebrate fatherhood. For some, this particular day will be the family celebrating with dad. Children will bring a card; others will call dad to congratulate; others gather for a family meal. Some fathers might celebrate with their sons who became fathers in the past year, and for those whose father went home to be with the heavenly Father, this day will be a day of remembrance. Father's Day is a day to celebrate, even for those who have never been a father. But all of us have a father to honor or to remember. Yes, the family is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him.

So, whichever way we celebrate Father's Day, we must find the object of our worship to be higher than our earthly relationship. As Christians, we have a Heavenly Father we celebrate. It is especially appropriate this year, since the 17th is a Sunday.

On one occasion the disciples heard Jesus pray and they were so impressed that their immediate response was, "Teach us to pray." WEAAD ~ World Elder Abuse Awareness Day

Friday, June 15

WEAAD – World Elder Abuse Awareness Day – was started in 2006 to bring greater recognition and awareness of the mistreatment of older adults wherever they live throughout the world and to highlight the need for appropriate action.

If you, or someone you know, think they might be experiencing abuse, feel free to call the **Seniors Abuse Support Line at 1-888-896-7183** – they provide information and referrals 24 hours a day.

What do older adults need to know?

- Everyone has the right to be safe and free from abuse. A person's value and feelings do not become less important with age. Abuse at any age is wrong.
- The person being abused is never responsible or to blame for the abuse.
- People who behave abusively towards an older adult can still love and care about them. They need help. Abuse does not go away and often gets worse over time.
- No one who is being abused is alone. Help is available.

Where can someone go for help?

- Call the 24 hour Senior's Abuse Support Line, 1-888-896-7183 and speak to one of our trained and caring counsellors.
- You can call the Seniors Abuse Support Line even when you are not sure that what you are experiencing is abuse. We can help.
- Talk to someone you trust: a physician, lawyer, elder, clergy, public health nurse, police officer, neighbour or a trusted friend or family member.
