

### From the Chaplain's Desk

An excellent wife who can find? She is far more precious than jewels.

Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised. (Proverbs 31:10,30)

"God could not be everywhere, so He made mothers." While this old Jewish saying is theologically not accurate, it describes the significant role of mothers beautifully. Mothers are the greatest gift of God to humanity. Since raising the children is primarily the mother's task, they instill important social characteristics to the next generation. Children learn virtues, such as sharing, loving others, and compassion from their mothers in their daily upbringing.

The closing chapter of the book of Proverbs is an excellent testimony to women. It speaks of the beautiful and indispensable role women play in God's creation. Here the writer speaks of children and husbands rising up in praise and blessing. "Many women have done excellently, but you surpass them all." It is not charm or beauty that is to be praised but a woman who fears the LORD, because she realizes that it is God who designed and equips her to be a mother. All her strength comes from God's loving hand.

God gave women the great gift to nurture, and so, generation after generation it is the mother's task to nurture children and the whole household. It is no wonder then that the mother's nurturing love is used as a metaphor in the Bible. The apostle Paul described his passion for the church using the metaphor of a mother's love: "But we were gentle among you, like a nursing mother taking care of her own children." (1 Thess.2:7) In Isaiah 66:13, God told the people of Israel that He would comfort them like a mother comforts her children.

This Mother's Day, I hope that we will take the time to say thanks and remember the sacrificial love, care and comfort we received from our mother. I want to say thank you and God bless you to all the mothers for all you have done to prepare your children to become the next generation of good men and women.
