From the Chaplain's Desk

"Joseph, a Levite and Cypriot by birth, the one the apostles called 'Barnabas,' which is translated Son of Encouragement..." Acts 4:36

Barnabas seems to have been one of those individuals who excelled at bringing other people up. That's underscored by the fact that we know him better by his nickname than by his actual name of Joseph! Every other time we meet him in Acts or the epistles of Paul, he's called Barnabas, the Son of Encouragement.

Barnabas' open nature seems to have always been extending itself to those on the margins: He alone was willing to vouch for the newly converted Saul when other Church leaders were still afraid of his persecuting past (Acts 9:26-28). He was sent by the Apostles to help lead the new Gentile church in Antioch, when many members of the majority Jewish Church were still unsure whether the Gentiles should be included. He even brought Saul along to help (11:25-26).

But sometimes, even those who have been shown such mercy and encouragement aren't as willing to offer it to others. This seems to have been the case when (in Acts 15:36-41) Paul wanted to go back and encourage the churches he and Barnabas planted. Barnabas wanted to give a second chance to John Mark, a young Christian who had deserted them on a previous mission, but Paul doesn't. Finally, they have a sharp disagreement and part ways. Barnabas won't allow even his dear friend to be unwelcoming of those in need of love and encouragement. And it seems his example won the day, as Paul and John Mark were eventually reconciled (2 Tim. 4:11).

Barnabas offers us a wonderful example of the outstretched love of Christ, which extends itself to all those the world might not think worthy. May we take that love up in our own lives!



eras too.




