From the Chaplain's Desk

"Ask, and it will be given to you. Seek, and you will find. Knock, and the door will be opened to you." Matthew 7:7.

The call to endurance is one of the most difficult aspects of the Christian life. To go on asking after God, seeking out his will, knocking on the door to the Kingdom. Sometimes (especially in the face of hardships) it can feel exhausting, painful, even futile. The Christian life was aptly described by our Lord as one of carrying the cross (Mt. 16:24). It will feel like a painful journey, perhaps often one which may seem to be taking us nowhere we want to go.

But Jesus encourages us not to give up. "For everyone who asks receives, and the one who searches finds, and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened (Matt.7:8)."

No matter how dark things may get, the Christian life is not futile. It is taking us somewhere. It is all causing us to grow. Like James says in the opening to his epistle, "Consider it great joy, my family, whenever you experience various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. But endurance must do its perfect work, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking nothing (Js. 1:2-4)."

While it may not look like it in the present, the various trials of Christian endurance which we all experience are a part of the working together of all things for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose (Rom. 8:28). Therefore we look to Jesus in the presence of trials, and continue to ask after him, seek after him, and knock on the door of his Kingdom, knowing that some glorious day the answer will be given, the door will be opened.

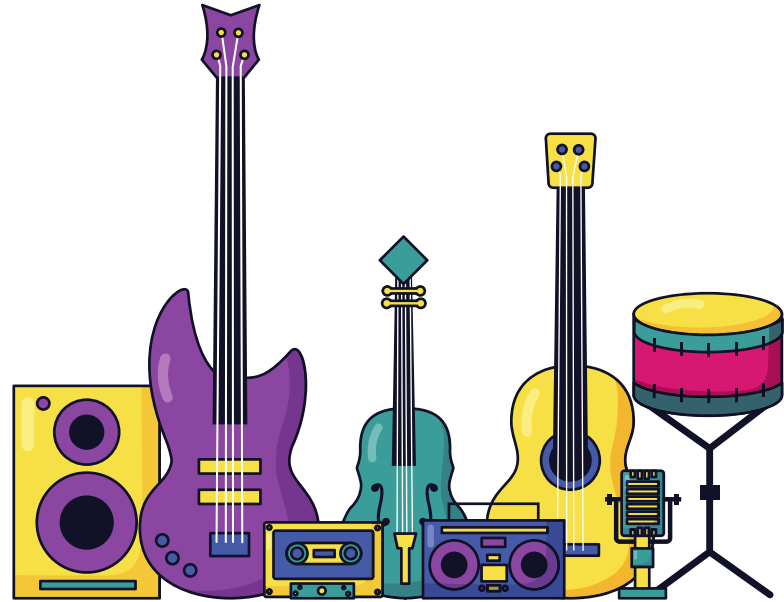

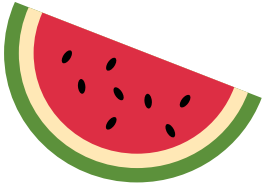
For July 11 & 18 - *while Janie is on vacation* - bring your favourite beverage out to the patio (or to the MPR if it's raining) and treats will be provided!
