From the Chaplain's Desk

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a new and living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead..." 1 Peter 1:3.

The great apostle Peter knew whereof he spoke when he wrote the passage at the top of this page. His own life had been completely transformed (for a second time) by an encounter with the risen Christ. We can recall the tragedy of Peter from some of the Gospels. Just before Christ's betrayal, Peter boldly declared: "Even if I have to die with you, I will not abandon you!" (Matt. 26:35.) But then, just a few verses later (26:69-75), he swears three times he does not know Christ. The realization of his failure of discipleship leaves him in bitter tears. Perhaps it's a feeling some of us have shared before.

Despite an encounter with the risen Christ (Lk. 24:34), Peter seems to think his failure to great to continue as a disciple, and returns to his former life as a fisherman. But Christ appears to him there too, calling him back to Himself three times, once for every time he denied Him. Thus Peter learned that the death and resurrection of Christ was truly the beginning of a new creation, for the whole cosmos and for his own life. Though he suffered the living death of sinful failure, the resurrected Christ comes to raise him from his sickbed, as He did for so many. As he can do for you today.

The resurrection of Jesus is the beginning of a whole new world. We are assured by it that sin and death no longer have any hold on us. "We are as He is in the world," says John in his letter. Therefore, because Christ rose, we can be assured of our own resurrection as well. And many 'mini-resurrections' in the meantime, as we begin in this life the passage from death in sin to life in Christ.
