From the Chaplain's Desk

"...as they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight."

(Read Acts 1:4-11.)

The Ascension of Jesus into His glory is one of the most significant moments in the Christian story. Far from merely being Jesus' 'roundtrip flight,' it is the moment when His victory over the powers of darkness won on the Cross and in the Resurrection is fully and finally sealed. It is the moment when Christ, fully God and now fully human, is enthroned at the head of heavenly glory. The Cross is Christ's coronation. The Resurrection is the celebration of His victory. The Ascension, then, is Christ's enthronement.

Jesus Christ is King over all the universe. He has been given "the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow (in heaven and on earth and under the earth) and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father." (Phil. 2:10-11.) Sometimes we might forget the fact, but Christ is already reigning over all things. It doesn't always look like it. The powers of darkness, though defeated, still try to cause as much damage as possible on their retreat. But "Christ must reign until all His enemies are put under His feet." (1 Cor. 15:25.) That 'putting-under' is going on right now as the Church, in the power of the Holy Spirit, proclaims the gospel, overwhelming the fleeing darkness by the ever-growing light of Christ. The light may be growing secretly, in the hidden spiritual places, so that it doesn't look to the unspiritual eye like anything has changed. But Christ is risen and reigning, and at the last, will return to set all things secret in the open, and cause the true light to shine forevermore.

Policy Posting

Smoking/Vapour Products

Stay informed with HavenGroup policies as we add them to the newsletter.

POLICY:

Steinbach Housing Inc. apartments including Fernwood Place and Linden Place, have established house rules which prevent smoking within the confines of their apartment unit, balconies and all shared common spaces. Therefore, smoking, tobacco/cannabis, and the use of electronic cigarettes, shall not be permitted in Steinbach Housing Inc. owned or leased complexes by tenants, employees, visitors and volunteers.

PROCEDURE:

1. Smoking of tobacco, cannabis and electronic cigarettes is not permitted within Steinbach Housing Inc. owned/ leased apartments complexes and residential properties.
2. Steinbach Housing Inc. shall provide designated smoking areas in the designated locations as follows:
 - a. Fernwood Place – edge of tenant parking lot (by the Maintenance garage)
 - b. **Linden Place – sitting area to the east of the tenant parking lot. (The Patio)**
3. There shall be no smoking within a minimum distance of ten (10) meters of an entranceway or building air intake.
4. No person shall smoke cannabis or use an e-cigarette to vaporize an e-substance containing cannabis at an outdoor public place, including Steinbach Housing Inc. designated smoking areas, sidewalks and outdoor parking lots.

Sharing the Patio

The patio is our designated smoking area, **but it is also a patio for ALL Linden Place tenants.** Please be a good neighbour and do your best to be considerate of those using the patio with you. ***Whether you are a smoker or a non-smoker***, please be willing to adjust where you are sitting so that the smoke can blow away from everyone and so we can all enjoy the patio together.

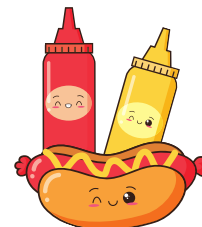
