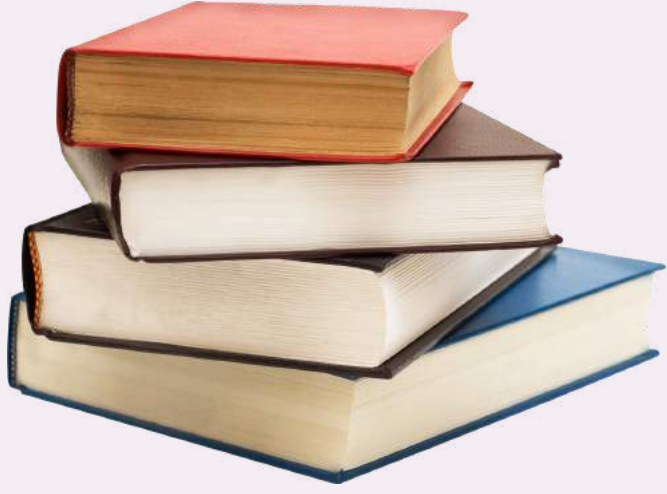

Emergency Response Information Kit (E.R.I.K.®)

This kit belongs to: _____

In the event of an emergency dial 911 first.

Here are a few tips to help you when calling emergency services:

- Identify yourself clearly;
- Clearly identify your place of residence (Phone number, Road or Street or legal address);
- Ensure your address is clearly visible. If it is dark, leave exterior lights on to assist emergency personnel.


WHAT IS E.R.I.K.®?

E.R.I.K.® is an Emergency Response Information Kit developed by the former Boni-Vital Council for Seniors in Winnipeg, Manitoba, in response to community concerns regarding the availability of adequate information in emergency situations. All area emergency groups have endorsed this program. Once completed, the kit provides the necessary information for emergency personnel to respond quickly to your situation.

The kit is ideal for seniors, chronically ill persons, those who live alone or who have caregivers, and others who have speech difficulties or communication barriers. You may want to take a copy of E.R.I.K.® with you when you travel, or go to the hospital in a non-emergency situation.

HOW DO I COMPLETE E.R.I.K.® ?

1. Complete both sides of the **Health Information Form**. A health care professional, a pharmacist or your family may be of assistance.
2. If you have a **Health Care Directive** or **Living Will**, place it in the kit and remove the existing form. If you wish to make a Health Care Directive, complete the enclosed form with your doctor and your family.
3. You may access an organ donation option by accessing <http://signupforlife.ca> or call 204-787-1897 or on you Manitoba Health Card.
4. Return the completed forms to the plastic folder and place the kit **on the front of your fridge**.
5. **Update** the information form as your information changes, if the kit is not current, it cannot help you.
6. Once your kit is complete, place the E.R.I.K. sticker on your main entrance door.

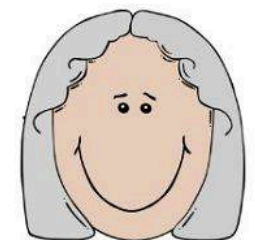

From the Chaplain's Desk:

“Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light!” Ephesians 5:14

Have you ever struggled with guilt in the Christian life? A inner sense of accusation, judgement? I have certainly been there. Many times I have thought, “I believe Christianity is true, but if that’s the case, I don’t know if I’m cut out for it!” But there’s a great mystery at the heart of the Christian faith, one which transforms death into life:

We are taught over and over again in the Scriptures that Christ will come again to judge the living and the dead according to their faith and lives. “For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known (Lk. 12:2).” But the great mystery of grace is this: For the Christian, this judgement takes place for us in this life. That is why confess our sins and repent. And in God’s great mercy, we are forgiven!

Moreover, because of His mercy, this judgement, this accusation of the Last Day, takes place for us now in the hidden depths of our heart, not out in the open for everyone to see. In this life, as we continually bring ourselves into Christ’s light in confession and repentance, we are cleansed of our sin. Therefore those who have revealed their whole lives, warts and all, to the light of Christ in this life through confession and repentance have nothing to fear from a second tribunal, for when that final light shines to reveal all things. Then we who have purified ourselves in Christ in this life will be shown forth radiant! So when you find yourself struggling with inner guilt, rejoice at the opportunity you’ve been given by Christ to cleanse your heart in this life! Rejoice in our present judgement, for the Kingdom of God is at hand in it!
