"A SEASON OF EXPECTATION AND JOY"

As we enter the Advent season, our hearts turn toward the incredible truth that God has given us the greatest gift of all—His Son, Jesus Christ. Advent is a time of anticipation, reflection, and preparation as we look forward to celebrating Christ's birth and also await His promised return.

Devotional: "Every Good and Perfect Gift"


