

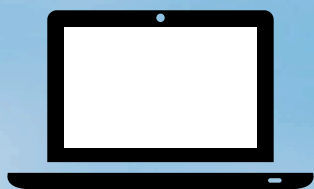

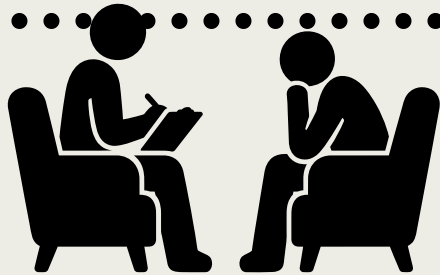

Chaplain's Corner

It is as the song writer says, "What a day that will be when my Jesus I shall see, And I look upon His face, the One who saved me by His grace; when He takes me by the hand, and leads me through the Promised Land, what a day, glorious day that will be."

He was ready and waiting for that day. Unfortunately, there are many, even in our city and community, who cannot look forward to that guaranteed fact of life, death. That is so because they have not made that commitment to be obedient to the call of Christ. Jesus said: "Come to me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. 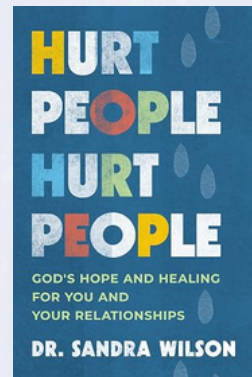
